C3 reports have been submitted and C4 is still in progress. I've asked the area directors to give a specific date when they want feedback from the club and to submit the report even if no feedback has been received.

Contests

The last of the 5 area contests will be tonight. I've started the basic planning for the division contest and will finalise roles in the next week. The division contest has been set for the morning of 2 December 2017.

Clubs

The clubs in Central now has an average membership of 13. Both Stanley College and Electric Toasters are likely to lose at least half their current membership at the next renewal. NAB insists that they are not in trouble but have only made 7 member payments to date, none of which include the President, Secretary or Treasurer.

New Clubs

Martin will work with Jon Teh to get Persuasive speakers chartered. Ross is helping with the documentation so we expect Persuasive Speakers to charter very soon.

Successors for Director Roles

Too early to tell yet. Garry Morris has asked to be reconsidered next year.

Other Information/Comments

I had a discussion with Deon about a possible project he can do as his HPL and we are thinking about doing a Central Division membership drive with guidelines on how to retain members for the longer term and a focus on the leadership skills that can be learned by serving as club officers. This will have a specific focus on Corporate clubs.
