The October & March renewals are key points for membership numbers and club strength within the District and there were a large number of members who did not renew, either with any club or reduced the number of clubs that they are members of.

The number of Paid Clubs is currently 74 clubs against a base of 82, which is a significant decline. In addition, the number of Charter Strength clubs has dropped from 22 to 20. Both these numbers have increased since the December DECM but the March renewals will give a better picture of how we are likely to finish the year.

Vision & District Success Plan

We have used the Club Officer Training platform to communicate our District Vision. It is important to communicate our vision with our members to align our vision with the club's own goals and vision.

The general Western Australian community will be aware of the District and Toastmasters and know us as a place to go to improve their communication and leadership skills. The District will have established a strong base of thriving clubs, generating members who want to be in and compete for all leadership roles.

The key focus on our Success Plan is to ensure we meet our membership goals.

We are currently behind our goal in this area and we need to prioritise our resources to this.

To date we have received 1,375 payments. The same time last year we were sitting with 1,624 payments.

District Officers

Since the last District Council Meeting we received the resignation of the Area Directors Douglas Mok and Martin Soh.

We welcome the appointment of the C1 Area Director Milvert Ling

With the resignation of the Public Relations Manager, Mina Cho. We are currently putting together a working committee to assist with the development of initiatives from a District level.

We are working on finding a replacement for the Black Swan Editor.

Club Rebuilding Initiatives

We have been actively promoting clubs to conduct Open House, Anniversary Meeting or Speechcraft Program it is great to see clubs taking on the important steps to recruit new members into their clubs.

The Talk Up Toastmasters Campaign has now started and ends on 31 March.

- Simply add 5 new members (duel or reinstated are also included in this count) during this period and your club will
- be rewarded with a Ribbon from Toastmasters International that you can proudly display on your Club Banner.
- Receive 10% discount on your next club order for merchandise purchased through Toastmasters Internatinal

Toastmasters International have announced two new awards for this program year.

1. District Club Strength Award

- This award looks at membership growth differently by focusing on the average number of members per club. When the District's average club size increases by 10% or more, we will be awarded the District Club Strength Award.
- At the start of January, we had an average of 15.53 members per club. If we can reach the goal of 17.08 member average will win this award for the District.

2. Club Building Video Contest

Any District who has formed a club this program year or by the time of submission is also invited to
participate in the Club Building Video Contest. To partake, create a 3- to 5-minute video describing the
specific strategies and tactics you used. Please note that each District is limited to one video submission
only and must be submitted by March 15, 2022 to participate. Resources and additional information
about the Club Building Video Contest are below.

District Conference & Contests
