Situational Analysis

In the 2020/2021 Toastmasters Term, District 17 started with 82 clubs. The membership number stood at 1316. During the year, 3 clubs paid the membership to become clubs in good standing, bringing the current number of clubs to 85. The membership stands at 1288. This is a drop of 2%.

One of the major setbacks resulting in the diminished membership was the onset of the Covid-19 pandemic. It was a shock to the system, disrupting meetings, contests, visibility, and growth. Since the lockdown came about quite abruptly, almost all clubs stopped dead in their tracks, totally cancelling meetings.

As the situation began to ease in May and June, some clubs returned to face to face meetings while others carried on meeting online. There were yet others who did not meet at all. It has been a slow start to the new year with many clubs just starting to meet again. Hopefully the COVID-19 situation does not throw a spanner in the works.

Membership

Eastern Division has 2/14 clubs with 20 or more members currently- Sunday Sundowners and Curtin. Those clubs with less than 12 members include: DTM Pathways, Swan, WA Speakers and Cannington Communicators not in good standing.

The average membership across Eastern Division is 14.5, as compared with the average of 12.5 at last report, with the range being 6-24. This is evidence of growth across the division that we would expect to continue, short of further restrictions.

Distinguished Club Program Goals

ED has 4 clubs have 5+ DCP goals earned and 2 clubs have 5+ DCP goals earned and 20+ or +5 members so far. These figures are impacted of course by COVID, how many members were lost, changes in venue, or use of Zoom etc.

Optimistically we may get 9 distinguished clubs, but membership will be the limiting factor. Of the 6 clubs identified as potentially reaching distinguished they need to increase membership on average by 5 members. This is significant growth that clubs will realistically struggle to achieve.

Club Officer Training

The table above shows that 11/14 clubs achieved the requisite number of club officers trained, with Cannington Communicators none, Swan 3 and Touch of Gold 3. For the next COT round these are the registrations as of yesterday:

I am coach at Swan Toastmasters and hope to help the club work back to charter strength. DTM Pathways is eligible for a coach, but they may not want one and they are in short supply.

New Clubs

If Cannington cannot increase its membership, they may fold giving way to the opportunity to start a new club. PQD mentioned the idea of setting up Demo Meetings in York and Northam to look at viability in these locations.

Successors for Director Roles

Ronnie Giandzi mentioned she was interested in a DD role. Todd Halvorson mentioned that he is interested in continuing as an AD. Neither party has nominated at present. I will ask the ADs about any other members who look like they may be possibilities to take on leadership roles.

Educational Awards

Of the 12 active clubs (Total – 14 clubs) educational awards have been lodged by 7 of those clubs, with 3 clubs having lodged 5 or more awards (Toasting Human Energy – 13 awards, City of Perth – 8 awards and bToasty – 8 awards). With some clubs not meeting yet until they are back face to face, this will impact on their ability to achieve a reasonable number of educational awards. Other clubs have members working on awards but not yet completed or lodged.

Membership

Of the 12 active clubs, 11 clubs have recruited new members with the success story to date being bToasty with 13 new members, while City of Perth have 7 and CGH and THE who have both recruited 6 new members.

More clubs are back meeting face to face or hybrid and having guests attend meetings, which is encouraging.

Distinguished Club Program Goals

Of the 12 active clubs, 11 clubs have obtained DCP points so far, with Toasting Human Energy having achieved 6 points and bToasty having obtained 5 points so far.

As mentioned above, clubs that are not yet meeting face to face will likely struggle to achieve DCP goals.

Club Officer Training

Only 7 of the 12 active clubs had the minimum number attend the first round of club officer training with 5 clubs having no one attend. While Inner City, traditionally struggles to get some of the corporate clubs to have club officers attend training, the number of clubs not attending was higher than last year and the overall number of officers attending was lower.

A COT session aimed specifically at the corporate clubs has been arranged for the 18 February and hopefully will attract more club officers from the corporate clubs in Inner City.

Contact with Area Directors

Online meeting has been held with the 3 Area Directors and planning to hold regular meetings. Starting to use Teams and have set up a Whats App group for communication.

Contests

Division contests for Humorous and Table Topics was held on 17 December 2020, while the contests for International & Evaluation are scheduled for 08 April 2021.

Clubs

Toastminers and Risky Toast had 0 members renew at the October renewals and were carrying 0 members into the renewal period. It is most likely that both these clubs will fold.

Some of the other clubs have struggled for new members and it will be interesting to see how many members renew during March.

New Clubs

There are currently 4 potential new clubs that have been identified (Petroleum Club/Engineers Australia and Vocus, which were identified last year; and Society of Petroleum Engineers and Wood Group).

Vocus has been holding meetings and is planning to hold a demonstration meeting when more staff are back working in the office.

Petroleum Club/Engineers Australia on hold due to COVID19 hopefully they will be able to hold a demo meeting in the second half of the year..

Wood Group is a new opportunity identified by Jeff Zhang and we are working to hold a meeting soon with their HR manager.

Successors for Director Roles

None has been identified yet.

Other Information/Comments

Suresh Prabhakaran (Area I42) has been working remotely for a considerable amount of time recently and we will be working to provide extra resources, etc as required.
