Introduction

With the March renewals just over, we can see that the District has had a significant decline in members with subsequent impact on club numbers.

With the continued post-COVID impact for the year to date, clubs have difficulties in attracting guests and converting them to members, as well as members electing not to attend meetings and to indicate that they do not intend to renew their membership.

Club Composition & Strengths

The following table shows the District and Division composition, membership numbers and club strengths as they currently stand (Updated at 28th April 2023).

Member Numbers

We currently have 750 members including multiple club members separately for all their clubs, which is a drop from 973 before the March renewals.

Hopefully we can grow member numbers during the remainder of the year to offset the number that we lose at the March renewals.

Membership Payments

The October & March renewals are key points for membership numbers and club strength within the District and in both October and March, there were a large number of members who did not renew, either with any club or reduced the number of clubs that they are members of.

Given that we currently have 1835 payments, which is a drop from the annual base number of 2377. It is noted that about 81% of the total membership payments are from renewed membership and the remaining 19% is from new membership.

The big challenges for the remainder of the year will be membership growth for existing clubs and to find resources within the District to support clubs in meeting this challenge.

Paid Clubs

The number of Paid Clubs with Active status (i.e., eight or more members paid for the renewal period) is currently 52 clubs against a base of 68, which includes 8 clubs with no renewal and 8 clubs at the status of either Ineligible (less than three renewing members) or Low (i.e., paid member count is fewer than 8).

The following clubs have zero member at the start of April 2023, which have recently elected to dissolve or decided to late last year, but they were included in our list of clubs at the start of the year:

- 1. Curtin GSB Club (0 member, ineligible)
- 2. Professional (0 member, ineligible)
- 3. 235 Toastmasters (0 member, ineligible)
- 4. Cannington Communicators (0 member, ineligible)
- 5. Southern River Toastmasters (0 member, ineligible)
- 6. Victoria Quay Club (0 member, ineligible)
- 7. Byford Toastmasters Club (0 member, ineligible)
- 8. Kwinana Toastmasters (0 member, ineligible)

In addition, there are other clubs with very low numbers, who are at risk of potentially failing. With the following clubs being of particular concern due to low member numbers, though most had been actively working to increase numbers:

- 1. OMTID Toastmasters (2 member, ineligible)
- 2. Applecross Toastmasters (3 members, low)
- 3. Events Hub Toastmasters Club (5 members, low)
- 4. Heritage Towns Toastmasters Club (5 members, low)
- 5. Currambine Toastmasters (5 members, low)
- 6. Perth Rainbow Toastmasters (6 members, low)
- 7. Perth Justalk (6 members, low)
- 8. Aspiring Leaders (7 members, low)

On a positive note, there are currently 6 clubs at the Charter Strength with more than 20 members. In addition, there are a few clubs with club members close to 20 some of which hopefully will reach Charter Strength by the end of June 2023.

With each Division, missing a least one Area Director, the Division teams have done a great job in getting all the contest completed during the year, as well as covering as many clubs as possible across the Area's with missing Area Directors.

Finance

A lack of resources at Toastmasters International to support the Finance Team, and significant delays in information being available, has resulted in Financial Reports that are effectively misleading and while the team has spent less that was planned, there are costs that do not currently show in the Financial reports that we currently have available.

Speech Contests

Toastmasters International has provided the District Executive Committee (DEC) with the choice of hybrid contests or online contests for Area, Division & District Contests, and at the first DECM it was voted to adopt the following:

- Area Contests Online
- Division Contests Online
- District Contests Hybrid

However the lack District resources, both from the District Team and the clubs to deliver a hybrid conference (TI requires that parts of the Conference are hybrid), led the Trio to make the difficult decision to host the contests as well as the other parts of the Conference online.

The current priorities for the District Team are to finish the year as strong as possible and help set up the incoming team for success, by concentrating on the following:

- Hold the District Council meeting
- Continue to support current clubs
