The October renewals period was not as strong as we had hoped and this is apparent in our current Club Status and Membership payments.

The October & March renewals are key points for membership numbers and club strength within the District and there were a large number of members who did not renew, either with any club or reduced the number of clubs that they are members of.

The number of Paid Clubs is currently 72 clubs against a base of 82, which is a significant decline. In addition, the number of Charter Strength clubs has dropped from 22 to 16.

The following clubs have recently elected to dissolve or decided to late last year, but they were included in our list of clubs at the start of the year, these clubs may show as either Suspended or Ineligible:

There are also a couple of other clubs with very low numbers, who are at risk of potentially failing, but we are working with this clubs to assist them to build their membership strength.

On a positive note, we are working to establish a number of new clubs and some of these are likely to charter either by the end of the year or early next year, these prospective clubs include:

- PTA/DMR Corporate Club
- Off The Cuff

We are also working on some leads including the following:

#### **District Success Plan Status**

#### **Vision & District Success Plan**

#### With the development of the District Success Plan, we have established the following vision:

The general Western Australian community will be aware of the District and Toastmasters and know us as a place to go to improve their communication and leadership skills. The District will have established a strong base of thriving clubs, generating members who want to be in and compete for all leadership roles.

With development of this vision we can operate with clarity and with purpose. It is a vision that is exciting and will require a lot of development and work to realise.

One of the important initiatives that has come out in the District Success Plan is to establish a goal to develop a longer-term outlook strategic plan for the District. This will enable us to plan for the next 5 years and develop initiatives that will have a long term focus.

As we are coming out of the turbulent period of Covid we are working towards plans to support clubs to rebuild and return to charter strength. With many clubs with 12 or less members clubs they remain vulnerable without immediate support. We have also had several clubs close recently as the members at the club were not in a position to keep them going. Whilst this is disappointing to see it sometimes is inevitable when clubs are reliant on several crucial members to hold the club together and when these members need a break there is not sufficient support to continue with the club.

At the same time we are working on the establishment of new clubs and with the development of new clubs resources are being used to support these initiatives.

#### **District Officers**

Since the last District Council Meeting we received the resignation of the Finance Manager, Dan Franks.

We welcome the appointment of the new Finance Manager: Saman Perera.

#### **Club Rebuilding Initiatives**

The District Leadership team have attended many clubs meetings over the last few months. Whether it was for an Open House, Anniversary Meeting or Speechcraft Program it is great to see clubs taking on the important steps to recruit new members into their clubs.

#### **District Conference & Contests**

District 17 Trio met with the Conference Chair recently to work through the logistics for the 2021-2022 Conference.

The greatest challenge we face is that Toastmasters International has only provided the District with 2 possible options for the conference: to be held online or in a hybrid format.

The other uncertainty we face is the fact that the state borders have not reopened and with no clear plan in the next 6 months it will be very challenging to invite interstate or overseas speakers without significant quarantine and costs associated with it.
