b. Lieutenant Governor Education & Training

My LGET Trajectory for 2012/2013 is to:

- Plan and implement two quality sessions for both district officer & club officer training.
- Monitor the District's Education awards lodgment and encourage all clubs to achieve a minimum requirement of Distinguished Club Status.
- Oversee all aspects of the District Convention Contests and workshops.
- Plan and run five to six independent workshops during the current financial year.

Toastmaster Leadership Institute - District Officer Training

This year's DOT followed the successful structure of the previous year's DOT. We were successful in training all District Officers who attended. There are still three Northern Division Area Governors and one Central Division Area Governor to be cast. They will all be trained up before the August 31st Deadline.

The second session of DOT – mid year training will take place in February 2013 following the District Executive's mid year Training.

Toastmaster Leadership Institute - Club Officer Training

275 Club Officers trained **(61.38%)** out of **448**. Minimum requirements **256** officers – **(107.42%)**

51 out of 64 clubs at least 4 officers trained (79.69%).

- 14th July 2012 Northern Division 78 attendees + 5 Kalgoorlie 38 surveys filled out
- 19th July 2012 Southern Division 112 attendees 62 surveys filled out
- 22nd July 2012 Central Division 80 attendees 50 surveys filled out

The Club Officer Breakout Sessions were all well received. There were positive comments on the benefits of the educationals' and relevant information packages. Club Officers commented on how the relevant information will provide a foundation for them to fulfil their roles and successfully carry out their duties.

- Technical challenges been addressed prior to the session commencing. Both Saturday and Sunday sessions were noted for internet challenges. Thursday was the most successful.
- Changes in the agenda (as a result of technical challenges) announced immediately.

As we concluded the first month of this Toastmasters year we have seen the new look dashboard for club, area, division & district results. This has given me a practical means of gathering information for this report and for our training in Orlando.

Membership Building & Retention

I have reminded the VPM groups at TLI about the membership building contests and have sent a further email to all presidents and VPMs, as August 1 saw the beginning of the Smedley Award period. I have encouraged all clubs to strive to achieve this award and strengthen their membership.

At TLI I encouraged VPMs to run the Moments of Truth workshop in their club to pin point areas which are beneficial as well as areas of concern. I will be following this up with further contact in the next few months.

The visitor pack was enthusiastically received at the VPM breakout sessions at TLI and several VPMs have contacted me to use our templates. I think consistency will help all clubs in this area.

The Marvellous Membership contest was only placidly received but I envisage more enthusiasm as the year evolves. As clubs begin achieving elements of this award I will send emails to encourage them to meet the next element. I believe it takes a while for new contests to be understood and implemented. It is exciting to report that 4 clubs have already achieved membership goals in the DCP with Stirling heading this group having achieved both goals.

New Clubs

To date we have 7 possible new club leads. They are; Maddison, Charlie Gairdiner Hospital, Curtin GSB 2, Phoenix, Corporate club in Canning Vale, BHP (City Square) and the WA mines Department.

David Nicholas, one of our New Clubs Co-ordinators is confident of most of these forming and I will be working closely with David to see as many as possible through to fruition.

The Club Sponsors, Mentors & Coach Program (SMAC)

To help build new and support challenged clubs I will be implementing a program to recruit, train, and supervise club sponsors, mentors, and coaches. All of these roles will help us build and maintain strong clubs where member's needs are met.

I think all of these roles are vital to the success of the district and I will be networking with other districts in Orlando to discuss the best method of putting this program into place.

Conclusion

It looks to be an exciting year with much demanding work but I am confident we have the team to achieve our expectations. I hope to bring new skills, knowledge and resources back from District Training and International Convention.
