a. District Governor

d. LG Marketing

District 17 is now steaming towards our goals in all areas of membership building, new clubs and coaches however, I believe we still need to remain focused and ensure we meet these by Convention when International President, John Lau, visits. The Re-alignment Committee has presented the proposal to all club Presidents and there have been several reply emails discussing other options.

Membership Building & Retention

If the Toastmasters International figures are correct, our membership payments to date are 2374 which is 91.7% of our distinguished district goal. New members so far this year is at **483**, renewals are **1810** (786 April Renewals) and Charter members are **81**. We hope the Charter Members figure will rise soon as several demonstration meetings are to be held in the next few weeks.

Membership Building DCP Goals

As of the April 4th reports, 50 of our 66 clubs have achieved the first membership building goal and 27 of these have already achieved the second. A further 5 clubs have added 3 new members and are closing in on the first goal while 5 of the clubs that have achieved the first goal have an additional 3 new members, therefore closing in on the second goal.

New members to April 4th are **483** compared to **416** at the same time last year.

New Clubs

Northern Gourmet is chartered and an inside contact tells me they will be distinguished this year.

After our successful demonstration meeting at **KPMG** I expected this club to charter during February. Lauren has given all the information to the temporary committee to get the bank account etc before they will proceed. I will follow up this week to see if I can get in direct contact with one of these people.

Willetton Toastmasters are holding a demonstration meeting on Monday April 8th. Fiona McLean has lodged the Application to Organise and has the marketing plan in order. This club will relieve pressure on Canning Vale Toastmasters as several members who live in that area will transfer to Willetton once it charters.

During this month I have had contact from *URS* and we are holding a demonstration meeting on Wednesday April 17th. I expect this club to take a little time to charter but I am quietly confident.

David Nicholas has been working with Patrick from Seasons Funerals in Canning Vale regarding setting up *Canning Vale Storytellers*. David has lodged the application to organise and is negotiating a marketing plan but I have had no update on this club lately.

I have had little contact with Maddy from *Workforce Development* so this is on my "To do list".

Club Coaches

Mundaring and Mandjar now have 14 members; however I believe they should be still on our critical list. Highgate, Armadale and Margaret River are clubs eligible for a club coach. I am on the lookout for other members willing to step up as Club Coaches.

Re-alignment Committee

The Re-alignment Committee have presented our report to Club Presidents for discussion and I have had several reply emails with other options which should all be discussed at our District Council Meeting at the Jewel in the Crown Convention in May.

April Renewals

Touch of Gold are still showing as "Low – Minimum requirement not yet met". Cannington Communicators, TLI Training Group, Madison, Perth JusTalk and Victoria Park are yet to record any April Renewals. Perth JusTalk & Victoria Park have both contacted me during the week to say they are being processed soon, after some hiccups. I have sent emails to all the other Presidents, LGMs and Treasurers to remind them of this duty.

Graced Members

At this stage we have 547 "Graced" members across the district. I will forward the names to each Area Governor in the next few days for them to liaise with the clubs for follow up.

Conclusion

I am confident that we will meet our membership payments goal. Our new club possibilities are looking very promising whilst club coaches are being sought and appointed for clubs in need. The Re-alignment Proposal has been sent to Presidents and April Renewals are progressing reasonably well. Follow up will be made with clubs regarding "Graced" members this week. I believe we are on track to achieve at least Select Distinguished District Status in 2012-2013.
